Subtended are paras 1 and 2 (a) (c) and (d) of HQ AMF (02E) memo 082588 of 10 Oct 45: -1. It is clear from various reports reaching LHQ (02E) that more information has been obtained by interrogation in Rabaul than has been indicated in 1 Aust Adv 2 Ech Signals. 2. (a) Attached to a letter recently received from Department of External Territories was a copy of a memorandum dated 21 Sep 1945 from AIB regarding 158 former residents of Rabaul stated to have embarked for Japan from Rabaul in "Montevideo Maru" on 26 Jun 1942. (c) It was stated in AIB memo that the report about the personnel and of their shipment per "Montevideo Maru" was substantially confirmed by a written Japanese report to CO 4 (d) The Dept of External Territories has therefore asked the AMF for confirmation, but so far no list of names of personnel believed to be on board the "Montevideo Maru" has yet reached LHQ (O2E) from any AMF source in New Guinea. The only lists of names so far received of personnel believed to have been on "Montevideo Maru" have been from personnel released from Japan and are only sectional lists. It is requested that a report be obtained to show the reasons why this information was not passed in accordance with GRO 112/45. 3. The first direct information of persons who were embarked on "Montevideo Maru" received at this HQ and 1 Aust Adv 2 Ech was contained in a report by DADWGS First Army - Major MELVILLE on his return from RABAUL. This matter should have been reported in RABAUL by Major MELVILLE before he left. DA & QMG First Army
