



Through the final operations in which the Battalion was engaged BURKE'S coolness and ability to control and manoeuvre under fire was most pronounced.

At MONT ST QUENTIN on the 1st Sept. 1918. he rendered most valuable assistance to his Coy. Commander, moving freely amongst the men, regardless of personal danger.

At MONTBREHAIN on 5th Oct. 1918, C.S.M. BURKE who has already been wounded in the arm, was seen moving about siting posts, and personally directing the fire of the Lewis Guns on to the enemy Strong posts. Later in the day, when all the four Company Officers had been killed, BURKE reconnoitred forward of the Coy's position, and personally siting several new posts, and got the men allotted to them. He continued to expose himself regardless to personal danger, until wounded a second time. On a message being then sent across to another Company. Lieut CALVERT took over and BURKE evacuated.
