 in Victoria for their use & benefit to  
 do as they please with after my Death all  
 in & about the Dwelling is theirs going  
 my Eldest Son, Evan William Griffiths a  
 Home with them so long as he is single  
 and is good & kind to them, I also give  
 my aforesaid Daughters all my Interest in  
 the Property known as Fresh Water Point in  
 Tasmania aforesaid, if my Daughters  
 Marry the Leases the furniture for the  
 use & benefit of the single ones if the  
 three marry they divide what is left  
 Out of the Proceeds of the Estate of  
 Fresh Water Point, I leave my three  
 Sons, Evan William Griffiths Jones, George  
 Thorley Jones, and Richard Augustus Otterley  
 Jones ten pound each £10,0,0, or any sum  
 they may choose to give them, (that is my  
 three Daughters) Dated the 14<sup>th</sup> fourteenth

I leave my black crimp shawl, to be cut in two, half to Ada & a quarter each to Eliza & Emily Jones, my large Bible for Eliza, my Wool boxes for Emily, six sea spoons two to each, any of my clothes I leave to Ada Jones - the oil & paintings of their Father & Grandmother Jones and if they receive my Fathers Portrait they must divide peaceably among themselves Also if any Property left to me or Sydney Brown as Home Bush by my Mother, my benefit is to be divided among my surviving children Sons & Daughters, Home Bush is in Sydney New South Wales, I Jane Hooper Jones was born 14 November 1833 in Lancashire Tasmania & Married at Matthias Church Windermere East Tamar All money from Fresh Water Point I leave to my Daughters they are to receive the Rents until the Property is sold and then dispose of as I have directed  
 Jane Hooper Jones. November 22 1894
