Given below is information which we have received concerning persons in whom we know you are interested. .

101 Private Leslie CLAUDIUS. Enemy Civilian Internment Camp, Sime Road.

With reference to your list of the 14th December, 1944, we are now pleased to advise that the abovenamed has been liberated and embarked at Singapore for passage to Sydney per "Duntroon" on 19/9/45. We were later advised by the United Kingdom Liaison Staff that he had emplaned at Sydney, for Perth, on the 14th October, 1945.

Mr. Horace Oswald PLUMMER - Rabaul.

Further to your enquiry of the 2nd February, 1945, we regret to advise that we have been informed by Army that the abovenamed was reported Missing on the 1/7/42., and is now for official purposes presumed to be dead. He is stated to have been on board the "Montevideo Maru" - ex Rabaul.
