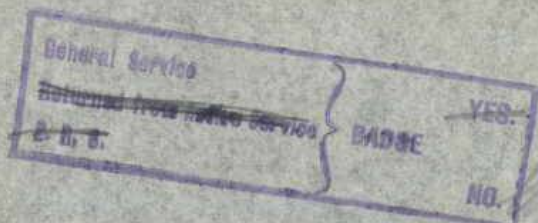

As I have already sent to the Air Board my application & a full account of my position here. I ask you for further help for Mrs Tille's release.

There are 1059 acres of land & it is situated 13 miles from Balahlava; which is my nearest shopping centre. My only way of getting about is by horse & trap, as I am unable to manage a car, with the children on these very sandy & hilly roads.

Before Mrs Tille's enlistment we kept a great number of sheep, pigs, cows & fowls. But now owing to the state of the fences & out buildings I am unable to keep a few cows. & as my children are very young; ages 10 months, 2½ years & 5 years, I feel they would be better if they were able to have fresh milk instead of ~~condensed~~ powdered milks, but the mending of the above, I am unable to manage.

I have also sent the air board a certificate saying, that owing to internal trouble, I am unable to do justice to my children: & as I have to prepare my own wood, & do other work, which I

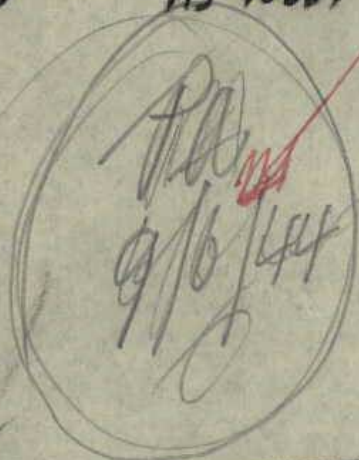

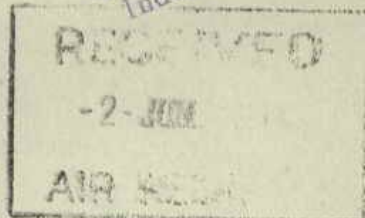

I hereby apply to be transferred to reserve R.A.A.F. and the grounds of my application are as follow:

1. I have been engaged in farming, apart from my service in the R.A.A.F. for the past 15 years and I am the owner of a freehold farming property at Balaklava, South Australia, having an area of 1058 acres. I am married and have three children under the age of five years.
2. When I applied for admission to the R.A.A.F. arrangements had been made by me for the letting of my property on terms which would ensure that I would receive some income therefrom and that I would also be able to meet the considerable commitments which were outstanding on the property.
3. The lessee of my property failed to carry out the terms of his agreement with me and during his tenancy neglected to keep the property and its improvements in order, and failed to meet commitments to me and failed as arranged to take off crops to which I was entitled. As a result of this I suffered severe financial loss.
4. Notwithstanding this loss I decided not to apply for my release from the R.A.A.F. as I believed that my father Mr. H. A. Tiller of Balaklava might be able to attend to my property and to ensure that commitments were met and also to ensure me some income therefrom. My father subsequently lost his health and was unable to carry on with my property, and I applied for my release from the R.A.A.F. having in mind that I might be able to assist him also. However, as my father informed me subsequently that he might be able to assist in supervising my property and I had made arrangements, which I believed were satisfactory, for the letting of the property, I did not press my application for discharge.
5. My father now proposes to retire from farming and the further lessee of my property has now left it and I am unable to make any arrangements either for letting or for sale or sharefarming on any terms. The lessee has completely neglected the fencing which is in a state of very bad disrepair and has allowed rabbits on the property to such an extent that unless I am able to return to it, it will be completely ruined, owing to drought conditions and sand drift.
6. I desire to return to my property for the purpose of putting the improvements in a proper state of repair and bringing the land back into reasonable condition. I propose to concentrate on the growing of barley and the raising of pigs and anticipate that I will run 15 cows and such number of sheep as the property will carry from time to time.
7. It is essential that I return to the property, as failing this, the commitments on mortgage will increase to such an extent that I will have no hope of meeting them and I will not only lose the property but will also be unable at any time to meet the liabilities which will have been incurred.
8. If I can return immediately and commence my farming operations it is probable that a scheme of debt adjustment would be

He must stop still till the pain loses its grip, in other words till the enforced rest allows the heart a chance to regain a circulatory balance. Of late he has also had severe pain in the left hip.

He is fit for only supervision or light, not-sustained, work

SUBJECT: Re Leave for No.48783 ACI Tiller.H.R.

I beg to report that Mr.Hurtle Alfred Tiller of Balaklava and the Father of No.48783 ACI Tiller H.R. is the owner of 1110 acres of Land, which is situated 12 miles north of Balaklava.

The Land which he owns consists of mainly grazing and farming land and at the present time Mr.Tiller has about 240 acres of this land under crop, which will have to be harvested in about a month's time.

In view of the fact that Mr.Tiller is suffering from a weak heart, I would suggest that his son A.C.I. H.R. Tiller be released from the R.A.A.F. to assist his father.

This appears to me to be a bona fide case and in view of Mr. Tiller's Health Conditions at present, I would suggest that his son be released.

He gets shortness of breath and breast-pang which compels him to stop still for a few minutes before resuming motion. Dear Sir,

I am writing this letter to you, asking if it is at all possible for me to get a discharge of my son 48783, ACI TILLER. H.R. to help me with my farm work. The work on the farm is getting more than I can manage, rabbits have become so numerous that they are over-running the farm, and must be destroyed. I have 800 sheep to attend to, also 40 pigs and 12 cows which I help my wife and daughter to milk, and have 15 horses to feed and care for. My health has been failing me very much of late, and I find I cannot carry on without help. There are still 300 lambs to be shorn and the sheep to dip, and the hay and wheat harvest coming on. The only help I have is my daughter (a girl in her teens). It isn't possible to do it on our own, as stooking and carting hay is very heavy work, and in my state of health I know I cannot do it without a man's help, that is why I am asking if it is possible at all the release of my son, as the farm work is getting beyond me. My other son is in the A.I.F. which he joined over 3 years ago, so am asking if you would please give this your earnest consideration. Hoping for a favourable reply,

Dear Sir,

I am writing on behalf of my husband, Mr. H. A. Tiller, (who is in a very poor health) asking you if there is any possible chance of us getting a discharge of our son, 48783, A.C.I. Tiller H.R. as in Mr. Tiller's indifferent health he cannot do the work on the farm now, he has the help of his daughter (a girl in her teens) but the work is getting too much for them.

On account of Mr. Tiller having a bad heart and rheumatism, it means they cannot lift a bag of wheat or super, so have to rebag it all into half bags, which is a lot of work, and he should normally be able to drill 20 acres a day, but when he has done 9 or 10 acres he cannot go any further and there is still 180 acres to put in, a job Mr. Tiller never intended to do until his share farmer gave it up last February, so he has had to buy horses and will now have to buy hay to feed them and will want help to get it carted.

There are 500 ewes and lambs to see every day, also cows and pigs, things are in a very complicated state at present owing to sickness and cannot possibly go on like this much longer.

Will you please give this your earnest consideration and help us out of our difficulty.

Early in the New Year, Mr. H.R. Tiller's farm comes back on our hands and it will be impossible for us to try and do it on our own. Trusting you will consider this as we are so badly in need of help.



CONDITIONS GOVERNING ENLISTMENT, PROMOTION, RE-MUSTER, TRANSFER AND DISCHARGE.

Candidates must make themselves familiar with the following information:—

1. On enlistment, airmen become subject to the Air Force Act and Air Force Regulations as amended from time to time and Orders promulgated under the authority of that Act and the said Regulations.
2. Enlistment will be for the duration of the war and for a period of not more than twelve months thereafter.
3. Enlistment is for service anywhere, and no guarantee can be given as to location at any time, but the wishes of personnel will be considered as far as the exigencies of the Service permit. Airmen must be prepared to serve overseas or in Australia.
4. Promotion to higher ranks, re-muster to other trades, and transfer to other units are governed by the following factors:—
 - (a) the requirements of the Service;
 - (b) the existence of vacancies;
 - (c) the special qualifications of an airman for holding any position other than that to which he has been appointed.
5. Promotion, re-muster, or transfer is always by selection and cannot be claimed as a right by any airman.
6. Re-muster to another trade is subject to the applicant having passed the prescribed trade test, and subject to vacancies occurring in approved establishments.
7. The passing of an examination for promotion, or a trade test for re-muster, does not entitle the airman to immediate promotion or re-muster, as promotion is always governed by the conditions set out in paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 above.
8. An airman may be discharged at any time for any of the reasons laid down in Air Force Regulations.

10. If an airman after enlistment desires to change the location of his household, the cost of removal of furniture from his place of residence to his place of enlistment or to any place of subsequent posting must be borne by the airman. No portion of this expense is payable by the Department.
11. Airmen receive free medical and prescribed free dental treatment. Their wives and children will not receive free medical or dental attention.
12. The rates of pay and allowances for airmen, particularly the group in which enlistment is made.





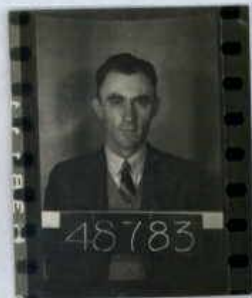
