Dear Madam,

With further reference to the report of burial of your husband, the late No. 6530 Private H.H.S. Marshman, 50th. Battalion, I have to inform you that arrangements are now being made by the Imperial War Graves Commission to proceed with the erection of permanent headstones in the Divisional Collecting Post Cemetery Extension, and in order to afford you the opportunity of selecting a personal inscription, etc, I should be obliged if you would kindly complete the enclosed Memorial Form "A" and return same to this Office at your earliest convenience.

You are reminded that any verse or epitaph submitted for this purpose should not exceed 66 letters, including spaces between words (each space counting as a letter) and that the cost is estimated at 3^d. per letter. With this exception the whole of the expense of erecting the headstone is being borne by the Government which is also responsible on a contributory basis for the future maintenance and upkeep of the military cemeteries abroad.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to previous correspondence in which you were informed that Private H.H.S. Marshman was reported to have been buried at Zonnebeke, East-North-East of Ypres. It has been found necessary to exhume the bodies of British Soldiers buried in isolated and scattered graves and to re-inter them in cemeteries.

During this work the graves of Private Marshman and several of his comrades were found, and their bodies have been re-interred in certain graves in Divisional Collecting Post Cemetery Extension in order to ensure the permanent and suitable maintenance of their graves.

I regret that when this work was accomplished it proved to be impossible to identify the remains of Private Marshman individually and instructions have therefore been issued for the erection over one of the graves of a cross bearing his name, regimental particulars and date of death, and an inscription reading "Buried near this spot".

The full number of the grave is Plot 1, Row J, Grave 1.

I am to assure you that the reburial was conducted with due care and reverence. The grave is registered in this office.

The numbering of the grave must for the present be regarded as provisional and liable to alteration.



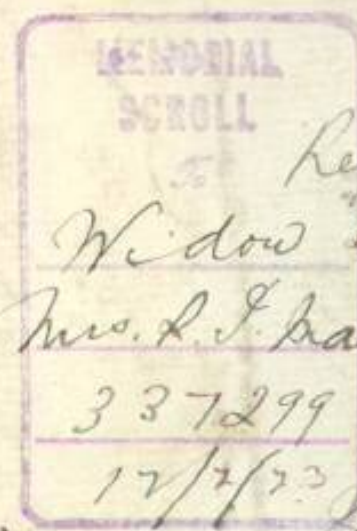

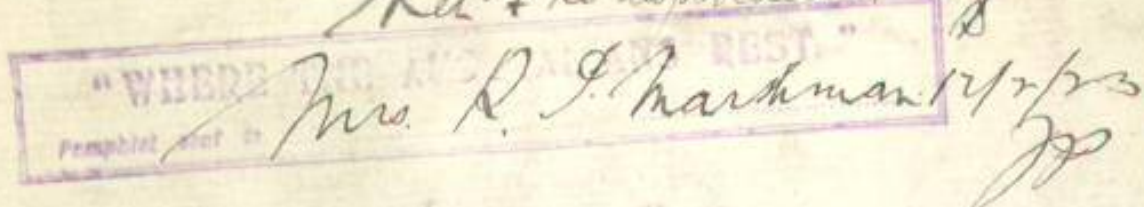
